## CUYAHOGA COUNTY CLOSES EAST CLEVELAND ADULT ACTIVITIES CENTER SAW, Inc. redirects individuals with developmental disabilities to other locations

**Maple Heights, OH** — SAW Inc., which provides services for adults with developmental disabilities, has received word that the Cuyahoga County Board of Developmental Disabilities (CCBDD) has made the decision to permanently close its East Cleveland Adult Activities Center (AAC). SAW is working to accommodate individuals at one of its five other locations.

“SAW, Inc. is dedicated to continuing to serve all adults with developmental disabilities equally in Northeast Ohio,” SAW, Inc.’s CEO Judy Carey said.

The center has remained closed since Governor DeWine ordered all adult day program locations to shut their doors in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. SAW’s other five AACs reopened in July 2020 and have continued to operate under enhanced state and local health and safety guidelines.

SAW provides adult day services including vocational habilitation, vocational training, community-based group employment, and more at five facilities around the greater Cleveland area including Rocky River, Maple Heights, Parma, Beachwood, and Euclid.

“As we continue to welcome back individuals to our facilities, we are also preparing new programs and opportunities for recent graduates,” Carey said.
